ABOUT

Assemblymember Chris Holden was first elected to represent the 41st Assembly District in 2012. Proposition 47 and Proposition 57 were ballot initiatives that reformed various criminal justice statutes once passed by California voters. Assembly Bill 109, the Public Safety Realignment Act, was enacted to reduce the number of inmates in the state's prisons as ordered by a U.S. Supreme Court decision. I'm bringing together subject matter experts in public safety, probation, and reintegration for this educational event to provide up to date information on these ballot initiatives and to answer questions from the community.
